INTRODUCTION & LEGISLATION

The 2023-2024 Maine People Before Politics People's Jobs Report is designed the gauge the work of the 131st Maine Legislature with respect to policies that promote economic growth, lower costs for Maine people, restrain government spending, minimize mandates placed upon small businesses, and reform Maine's bloated welfare system. Every year special interest groups dominate the halls of the Maine State House with their hands out. Luckily, we have followed this legislation closely and compiled this report card to let you know where your State Senator and State Representative stand on these important issues. Following you will find a compilation of each of these graded roll-call votes, with a brief synopsis of what each piece of legislation did:

Common-Sense Welfare Reform: LD 117, would have limited the use of welfare benefits from being spent on things such as vacations to Disneyland, liquor, and other adult entertainment. This is an incredibly popular common-sense welfare reform that Governor LePage instituted under his leadership. Governor Mills rolled back this common-sense welfare reform and opted for the status quo which provides too many opportunities for welfare fraud and abuse, at the expense of hardworking Maine taxpayers. Maine tax dollars should not be allowed to be used to fund vacations out of state, buy booze, or fund other adult recreational habits. Promoting a welfare state undermines the cornerstone of our economy: hard work. We must support reforms to move people from welfare into the workforce. This bill was defeated in the Legislature. The MPBP position was to support this bill by opposing the ought not to pass motion. **MPBP Position: NO**

Tax Increases to Mandate Paid Family Leave: As part of LD 258, the biennial budget bill, lawmakers mandated that eligible workers in the private and public sector will have 12 weeks of paid time off available to them for family or medical needs beginning in 2026. Unfortunately, this law is funded through a new tax on Maine businesses and employees. Not only will this law undoubtedly cost Maine businesses substantial amounts of money, but it also puts Maine property taxpayers at risk because the mandate applies to municipal governments. It is important to note that this is one item in a laundry list of items that were included in the budget, and not a standalone bill. This bill was passed and signed into law by Governor Mills. **MPBP Position: NO**

Mandated Overtime Wage Payment for Small Businesses: LD 513 aimed at increasing the overtime threshold that is part of Maine's wage and hour law, by over \$20,000, over a three-year period. This essentially requires Maine businesses to reclassify trusted and valued salaried employees as hourly employees, resulting in huge payroll increases. This increases the cost-of-business for Maine employers, and puts other employee benefits at risk. Ultimately, this bill was carried over and did not go into effect over concerns about potential conflicts with the federal rule governing the issue. **MPBP Position: NO**

Scheduling Requirements on Maine Small Businesses: LD 1190 would have put untenable restrictions on how Maine businesses can schedule their employees. This would handcuff employers to mandated scheduling parameters and not consider individual circumstances when individual circumstances arise. This is especially problematic in the context of tourism where weather and special events play a huge role in the number of staff needed. This bill would have financially penalized employers who have to make scheduling changes, making Maine an even more difficult place to do business. Businesses in Maine already operate on razor thin profit margins, and this would have only made things worse. This bill passed the House and the Senate but was carried over. **MPBP Position: NO**

Increasing Income Tax Rates for Some Maine Families: LD 1231 would have made substantial changes to Maine's income tax brackets and created higher taxes for wealthier residents. Under the bill, individuals who make over \$144,500 would be taxed at increasingly higher rates. This bill would have created a new top marginal income tax rate of 8.45%. Although the bill was a well-intended effort to lower taxes for working class Mainers, it was the wrong approach. MPBP supports increasing Maine's competitiveness by reducing the income tax for all taxpayers, with the goal of eliminating it. We do not support efforts that make Maine uncompetitive, such as increasing the top marginal income tax rate. **MPBP Position: NO**

Lowering Electricity Costs for Maine Families: LD 1347 sought to make sweeping changes to Maine's Net Energy Billing program in Maine. Currently, out-of-state solar developers are guaranteed massive profit windfalls off the backs of hardworking Maine families and businesses. Electricity costs have increased dramatically as a result of bloated solar subsidies funded by Maine ratepayers because the amount of the subsidy is tied to the cost of natural gas. This has resulted in over \$220 million in stranded costs that are passed onto Mainers annually. This bill would have restructured the Net Energy Billing program to lessen the financial burden on Maine families and businesses. Ultimately, this bill died. The MPBP position was to support this bill by opposing the ought not to pass motion. **MPBP Position: NO**

Prohibition on Noncompete Clauses: LD 1496 would have effectively eliminated the use of non-compete agreements in Maine, with very limited exceptions. There are currently limitations on where non-compete agreements can be used in Maine to provide adequate protections for Maine workers. However, businesses should be able to use these agreements to protect their own trade secrets, confidential information that is not a trade secret, and employer goodwill. Essentially, business owners would be required to build a business, with potentially industry-changing technology, without the ability to protect that time and financial investment. This will deter investment in Maine, and puts Maine at a disadvantage when trying to attract out-of-state companies. This bill was so outrageous that even Governor Mills vetoed the bill. Her veto was sustained and this bill failed to become law. **MPBP Position: NO**

Adoption of the National Popular Vote: LD 1578, one of the most egregious bills to come out of the 131st Maine Legislature, forces Maine to join the National Popular Vote compact. Under the compact, Maine's electoral votes will be awarded to the presidential slate that receives the most popular votes in all 50 states and Washington D.C., once enough states join the compact. This puts Maine at a distinct disadvantage because it guarantees that ultimately, California and New York will rule over Maine. The electoral college was put in place to ensure that rural voices were not stifled by a handful of larger states. Governor Mills allowed this bill to become law without her signature. **MPBP Position: NO**

Increasing the Cost of Already Expensive Healthcare: LD 1639 would have created the Maine Quality Care Act in order to establish minimum direct-care RN staffing requirements for Maine hospitals. As we all know, Maine hospitals are facing staffing shortages similar to other critical Maine industries. This bill would have driven up the cost of healthcare, with no guarantee that there would be improved outcomes. Who would pay for these increased costs? Consumers! Maine has an unemployment rate among nurses of 2%. This bill was carried over and has not become law. **There was no House roll call on this vote. MPBP Position: NO**

Softening Criminal Penalties on Theft: LD 2246 would have continued the “soft on crime” approach of Governor Mills and the extreme 131st Legislature. This bill would have removed the ability for prosecutors to charge someone with an automatic felony if they have two existing convictions for theft. Maine is ranked third worst in the nation for the prevalence and impact of retail theft, and this bill would have made it substantially worse. Maine's small businesses are suffering from the enormous cost of increases in theft, and that ultimately leads to higher costs being passed onto consumers. People need to be accountable for their behavior and removing this tool from prosecutors' toolbox would have caused substantial harm to Maine businesses. Luckily, Governor Mills vetoed this legislation and her veto was sustained. **MPBP Position: NO**

Special Note: This list is largely focused on bills that would have significantly increased the cost of doing business in Maine. This list is by no means exhaustive but does provide a glimpse into some of the most damaging proposals in Augusta. **We recognize that if you increase the cost of doing business, hardworking Mainers pay the price through reduced wages or more expensive goods and services. We must strive to create an environment where elected officials are focused on pro-growth economic policies that will make Maine more competitive.** We should be lowering taxes on hardworking Mainers, reducing electricity costs, and eliminating red tape that drives the cost of operating a business higher.

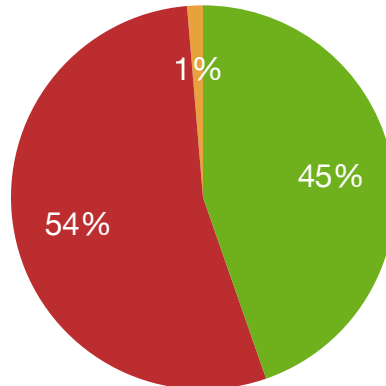

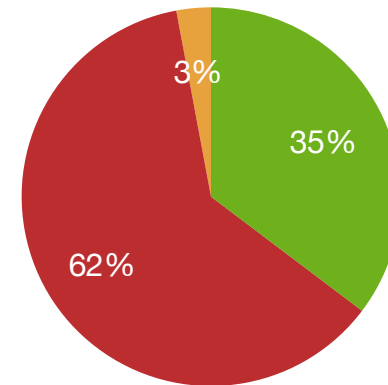
House Polarization
